Apprentice strike rate high

ALMOST all Year 12 students from technical colleges in South Australia have an apprenticeship to work in at the end of school.

Marcellin Technical College last year had a 95 per cent success rate from its two-year program.

In the first six months, students start a trade-focused SACE program and develop work-related skills for industry.

In the second part of the year, students start a school-based apprenticeship.

During the second year as Year 12 students, they complete SACE, continue training and enter the workforce as a school-based apprentice. Principal Jim Fenoughty says all students have achieved their SACE in the past three years.

"Over last four years, 95 per cent of the students have commenced an apprenticeship," he says.

"The other 5 per cent mostly secure full-time employment.

"We have had students in certain trade areas, for example, who now work in retail in that trade area."

He says the specific knowledge and skills acquired during their school years helped put them on the fast track to an apprenticeship.

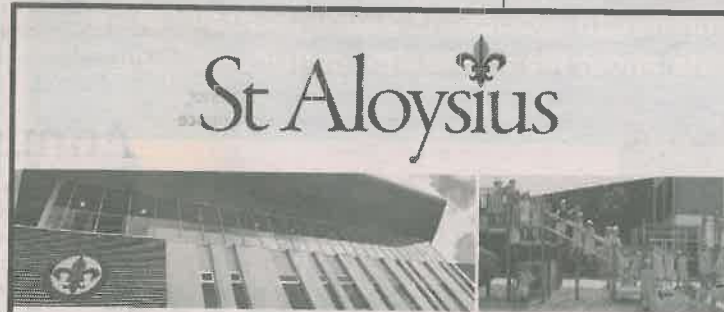

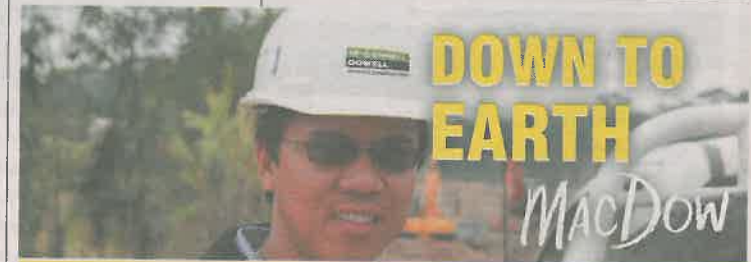
